“Crown Him Lord of All”

“Jesus reigns!” is the main point of Pentecost and this is proven by the “proof texts” Peter used in his sermon that day:

2 Sam. 7:12-16	One of David’s sons would establish his throne forever.
Psalm 16:9-11	This son would first be killed, resurrected, and enthroned in heaven.
Psalm 68:18	Having received spoils, he would then distribute them on earth (<i>c.f.</i> , Eph. 4:8).
Psalm 110:1-2	Beginning in Zion, this king would then extend his rule over all nations.

Discussion Questions

Personal: What is our proper response to the reality of Jesus’ inauguration as King?

Theological: Is our pneumatology sufficiently Christocentric (John 15:26)?

Eschatological: Why do many Christians speak as if David’s throne has not yet been established?

Evangelical: If Jesus truly is both Lord and Christ, why don’t we announce it more confidently?
